Program Overview and Logistics

Stormwater management regulations in Virginia and the mid-Atlantic region have undergone considerable revision in the past several years and their implementation and associated impacts on development and water quality are often hotly debated. This one day program will focus upon the current status of stormwater regulations in Virginia with a particular emphasis on nutrient and sediment control and current best management practices and control structures. The program will also include detailed materials and presentations on soil mix specifications for biofilters and bioretention structures, urban nutrient runoff estimation and issues, and overall low impact development (LID) planning approaches and strategies. Throughout the program, the speakers will focus on the role and need for soil science input to the planning and design process. The meeting will conclude with a field trip to view and discuss local stormwater management designs and actual LID implementation.
