To understand site hydrology, you must understand landscape position and stratigraphy of setting

Upward/downward flow generally predictable and affects water budget



"Hydro" Conclusions

Wetlands formed in different landscape settings can be substantially different

Wetlands formed in "identical" landscape settings can be substantially different



"Hydro" Conclusions

The history of construction practices in mitigation wetlands can alter the permeability of surface soils and subsurface strata by compaction, dessication, and deposition.
