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VIRGINIA POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (VPDES) AND CHESAPEAKE BAY PRESERVATION ORDINANCES – THEY SAY CHANGE IS GOOD?

VPDES Permit Requirement Changes from 5 Acres to 1 Acre

Effective December 4, 2002, the Virginia Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (VPDES) General Permit for Construction Activities VAR10 (formerly VAR 4) has been amended to reduce the amount of land disturbance requiring a general permit from 5 acres to 1 acre. Essentially, this amendment promulgates that any ongoing "small" construction activity (1- to 5-acres of land) that began before December 4, 2002 is now required to submit a Registration Statement with the DEQ by January 3, 2003. In addition, registered sites must have a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) that meets the requirements of the General Permit for Construction Activities within 30 days of the date of coverage under that Permit. Updated Schedule for Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance Changes in Northern Virginia

Every locality is making their Ordinance changes simultaneously. Don't complain. Be Pro-active! You can:

- 1. Review the ordinances relative to your sites and see how they affect you.
- 2. If you can't figure out what it does tell the respective locality's Planning Commission and Board of Supervisors or Town/City Council.
- 3. If you are affected, tell them how (give specifics) and what that means financially to you and the local tax base.
- 4. If you need more time, say so. CBLAD is willing to give more time to localities that ask for more time.

<u>The key is participation</u>. Many landowners, developers and engineers are complaining – but not testifying at the public hearings or providing written comments. Without your participation, the ordinances will not change.

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City of Alexandria

The City of Alexandria anticipates gathering public input on its Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance revisions in late March or early April, with official adoption of the new ordinance expected to occur in June, 2003. Draft revisions to the ordinance are not available at this time for public review.

City of Fairfax

The Planning Commission heard testimony on January 13 and decided to defer any decisions on the matter to January 27 at 7:30 p.m. (to be held at Fairfax City Hall.) The City Council is scheduled to meet on January 28 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. It is expected that many of the changes requested during the public hearing will be made by staff prior to the deferred decision hearing. City of Falls Church

The City of Falls Church has planned a council work session to discuss Chesapeake Bay Preservation Ordinance revisions on February 4 in the City Hall Training Room G03 at 7:30 p.m. The Planning Commission hearing has not been scheduled at this time, but is expected to take place sometime in March. Town of Herndon

The Town of Herndon anticipates a Planning Commission hearing on March 3, with a Town Council meeting to follow on March 11. However, these dates are still tentative. Fairfax County

Fairfax County's Planning Commission public hearing was held on January 15, but deferred the decision until Thursday, January 23 at 8:15 p.m. The Board of Supervisors meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 27 at 4:30 p.m. in the Board Auditorium at the Fairfax Government Center. However, it is expected that the Planning Commission will defer their decision for a longer period of time to allow the County staff to work out issues with the community-at-large, and thus the Board of Supervisors' meeting on this matter will likely be deferred.
